Directions: DRIVING DIRECTIONS: The FAA SAFETY CENTER/Orlando Field Office is located on Lakeland Linder airport. From Interstate 4, take County Line Road (Exit 25) south approximately 3.6 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn left on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the Central Florida Aerospace Academy Campus entrance. Proceed straight ahead on James C. Ray Drive and turn left onto Sun 'n Fun Road just before the closed airport gate. Continue on SUN 'n FUN road and make a left on Laird Road, the (back of) FAA Aviation Safety Center is immediately on your right, park on the west side of the building – not on the grass. From Highway 60, take County Line Road north approximately 3.8 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn right on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the Central Florida Aerospace Academy Campus entrance. Then follow the directions above beginning with James C. Ray Drive. From Lakeland take Pipkin Road west to Medulla Road, turn right and proceed about ½ mile to the Central Florida Aerospace Academy Campus entrance on the right.. Then follow the directions above beginning with James C. Ray Drive.

FLYING IN: The Safety Center/Orlando Field Office is located at Lakeland Linder International Airport (KLAL). After landing request taxi to the FAA SAFETY CENTER. Park in front of FAA Safety Center Building on the grass. After the event staff will be available to open the gate for exiting onto the taxiway.
