ADS-B is transforming all segments of aviation. Real-time precision, shared situational awareness, advanced applications for pilots and controllers alike – these are the hallmarks of ADS-B NextGen surveillance. Real-time ADS-B is used now for air traffic control. General aviation is safer with ADS-B traffic, weather, and flight-information services. Safety and efficiency improve with advanced ADS-B applications. ADS-B improves safety and efficiency in the air and on runways, reduces costs, and lessens harmful effects on the environment. By January 1, 2020, you must be equipped with ADS-B Out to fly in most controlled airspace. This is a live presentation only. Free seminar! WINGS credit available!
