As a Designated Pilot Examiner (DPE) Mark has administered over 500 practical tests in airplanes and gliders. During these tests he has found there are common factors which can contribute to an applicant's success as well as failure. Mark will couple his decades of experience as a hands-on flight instructor and Chief Instructor with his experiences as a DPE to help bring you information to help ensure your readiness for the Private Pilot – Airplane and Commercial Pilot – Airplane practical tests. Join Mark for this informational and objective event. Audience participation is strongly encouraged.

Directions: From the south, go up HWY 27 then take FL 60 W towards Tampa for 8.3 miles. Then turn right onto Rifle Range Road, for 2.8 miles, then turn left onto Bomber Road for 2.8 miles. Turn left onto Ben Durrance for 0.2 miles, turn Right onto Beechcraft for 0.4 miles, turn Left onto Cessna, for 0.3miles, then onto Airport Blvd on your left and follow to the FBO.

From Orlando, take I-4 W to exit 41 FI 570 W for 11 miles, then take exit 14 onto FL-540 W, turn into left lane to merge onto 540 E. Take right to Thornbill Rd follow approx 3.5 miles, onto Spirit Lake Rd, for 1.8 miles, to Airport Blvd, to the FBO. From Tampa, take I-4 E to exit 27 to FL 540 E, Take right to Thornbill Rd follow approx 3.5 miles, onto Spirit Lake Rd, for 1.8 miles, to Airport Blvd, to the FBO.
