- Accident Prevention Outreach (NPP)
- Public speaking, Creation of media
- Coordinate with stakeholders
 - Federal and Civil
- Administer Remedial Training (RT)
- Work with Volunteers (Reps)
- Awards
- Assist others and answer their questions
- Flight training on own time and dime!



What FPM's Don't Do:

- Surveillance
- Investigations
- Enforcements
- Initial certifications (Practical Tests)
- 709 rides
- Proficiency flying (EBC)

"WINGS" Program Review

- Lifelong program for GA proficiency
- Free to participate!
- Any Phase = Flight Review
- Addresses common GA Accident causes
- Three "Levels": Basic, Advanced, Master
- Infinite number of "Phases" for each Level
- Knowledge + Flight Credits needed
- Progress tracked on-line (faasafety.gov)
- Can work toward multiple Levels at once
- No time-out requirement for next Phase



Why Participate in "WINGS"?

- Any completed <u>Phase</u> = Flight Review
- Participants seem to be less accident-prone
 - Possible insurance discounts
- Incidental learning
- Ideally suited for flight training and testing!
- Earn free "Bling"! Win extra \$\$\$\$!

WINGS Incentives for DPE's

- Completed Phase = Flight Review!
 - Limited liability exposure via WINGS
- Can renew unexpired CFI via WINGS!
 - Must hold a current WINGS Phase yourself
 - Evaluate and endorse at least 15 WINGS flight training activities on at least 5 different pilots < 24 CM
 - Ref: AC 61-91J, Section 6(e).
- WINGS adds to your professionalism!
- Sets positive example for your clients!

WINGS "Cheat Sheets"

 Attached to our SPANS message; available on request!

 Shows Activity #'s for WINGS credit after most checkrides – 99.9% of what you do!

- Part 61 (One Step) = Part 141 (Two Steps)
- Designed as an insert for wallet / logbook

Remedial Training (RT)

- Alternative to enforcement; Voluntary pgm
- Idea: Make Airman better than before!
- FPM Interviews airman
- FPM creates customized RT syllabus
- FPM finds RT Provider (could be you!)
 - DPEs are among preferred RT Providers
- Airman and RT Provider (You?) meet for RT
 - Ground training always, Flight training often
- RT Provider may charge fair market value
- RT Provider reports back to FPM

Safety Outreach Activity

- Lion's share of National Performance Plan
- FPMs work with Reps, Industry, FAA et al
- Seminars, Webinars
- Major events (e.g. Sun-n-Fun)
- CFI Special Emphasis Program
- Advertise via "SPANS" e-mail messages
- DPEs ALWAYS welcome as Speakers!
- Speakers present on safety and other topics
- WINGS and / or AMT credit usually available
