# **AOPAs Jamie Beckett Discusses Non-Towered Airport Operations**

Many pilots assume, in error, that a non-towered airport is an uncontrolled airport. Nothing could be further from the truth. There are simple, well-established rules of operation for any pilot flying into or out of a non-towered airport. Learning these simple procedures, respecting the importance of implementing them in a predictable manner, and following through whenever you operate in a non-towered airport environment, can significantly enhance safety and prevent accidents. Come prepared to discuss your habits and learn new methods.
