Being well versed in these procedures will protect you from being frozen if your engine ever decides to go on Vacation while you're flying. Bring your pilot friends and flying partners.

Directions: On Waldo Road, go Northeast past the airport. At the NE 49th Ave stoplight, turn right, go 0.7 miles, and look for the hangar on the right side.
