

Orlando FSDO FAA Safety Team presents:

Best Glide Speed during Emergency Descents - Approaches - Landings

- Improved pilot knowledge of and proficiency in flying at best glide speed and configuration will increase the chances of a successful forced landing.

General aviation accidents have resulted from loss of control while maneuvering during emergency descents, approaches, and landings.

- The likelihood of executing successful forced landings can be improved through obtaining and maintaining Best Glide Speed or Minimum Sink Speed.
- Pilots should determine Best Glide and Minimum Sink Speeds for the aircraft they fly.
- Pilots should periodically train and practice to achieve and maintain proficiency in forced landings.
