Teaching Points:

- Basic survival knowledge and equipment can greatly improve odds of surviving after a forced landing.
- Dress according to the environment over which you're flying.
- Carry basic survival tools on your person.
- When flying to or over remote areas consider 406 MHz personal locator beacons and or satellite phones.
- The most important factor in survival success is the will to survive.
