Free two-hour safety presentation. **Driving:** Take SR-92 (Int'l Speedway Blvd) off I-95 or I-4 and follow signs to Daytona International Airport just east of the famous race track. Park in Short Term parking lot and save your entry ticket. Parking vouchers will be provided; parking is free with the voucher and entry ticket. Enter the main terminal building, go up the escalator or take stairs to second floor and follow the signs to the safety seminar just ahead. **Fly-Ins:** Sheltair is the closest FBO, about a 5-minute walk to main terminal. Let Sheltair know ahead of time, and show the receptionist your parking voucher obtained at the event.
