

Preventative Maintenance for General Aviation

Austin Eubank Director of Maintenance at Phoenix East Aviation's flight school will discuss FAR 43 Appendix A: Preventative Maintenance, and the most common maintenance practices during 100hrs/Annuals. Also, he will discuss the proper techniques and skills pilots should have while maintaining their own aircraft.

Free two-hour safety presentation. Driving: Take SR-92 (Int'l Speedway Blvd) off I-95 or I-4 and follow signs to Daytona International Airport just east of the famous race track. Park in Short Term parking lot and save your entry ticket. Parking vouchers will be provided; parking is free with the voucher and entry ticket. Enter the main terminal building, go up the escalator or take stairs to second floor and follow the signs to the safety seminar just ahead. Fly-Ins: Sheltair is the closest FBO, about a 5-minute walk to main terminal. Let Sheltair know ahead of time, and show the receptionist your parking voucher obtained at the event. Sheltair will not charge a ramp fee to seminar
