

## Loss of Control

Most Loss-Of-Control accidents are fatal. These accidents happen in both VFR and IMC conditions, during the day and the night. They are not limited to inexperienced or VFR only pilots. This seminar will explore some of the factors that can lead to Loss-Of-Control and will provide some practical steps that can be taken by pilots, to help avoid LOC.

In this seminar, we will conduct an "OPEN DISCUSSION", on how to prepare for, and conduct, safe flying, how to avoid loss of control, while in-flight.
