Most Loss-Of-Control accidents are fatal. These accidents are fatal. These accidents happens in both - VFR and IMC conditions, during the day and night. They are not limited to inexperienced or VFR only pilots.

This seminar will explore some of the factors that can lead to Loss-Of-Control, and will provide some practical steps that can be taken by pilots, to help avoid LOC.
