

Preflight After Maintenance

The speaker will discuss the importance of a thorough preflight after an aircraft goes through a maintenance repair/inspection. The do's and don'ts of avoiding issues which may arise after an aircraft is cleared by maintenance.

Take the turnpike merge into Ronald Reagan TPKE southbound, exit on SW 120 Street, make a right westbound towards SW 137 Ave onto the entrance to the airport, right turn on SW 128 Street and ADF Airways. It will be on your left at 14532 SW 129th Street, Miami, FL 33186.
