Ramp inspections are evaluations performed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to ensure that general aviation aircraft comply with safety standards and regulations. These inspections typically occur on the ground at airports and involve a thorough review of the aircraft's paperwork, maintenance records, and physical condition. The goal is to verify that the aircraft is airworthy and that operators adhere to federal aviation regulations, enhancing overall flight safety.
