

San Juan FSDO/FAASTeam and InterAmerican School of Aeronautics presents:

Aircraft Performance and Limitations and Loss of Control Issues

The event will only last ONE HOUR. We would like to start promptly at 6 p.m. and end at 7 p.m. Investigations of General Aviation Loss of Control Accidents often cite inadequacies in predicting aircraft performance and flight operations conducted outside of established aircraft limitations. The General Aviation Joint Steering Committee feels a substantial reduction in general aviation fatal accidents would result from better prediction of aircraft performance and adherence to aircraft operating limitations. We will discuss these issues.

Additionally, we will have a "hands-on" training session to help participants access and understand their FAASafety.gov account, including the area for the WINGS Program. We are requesting that every attendee bring their laptop computer or other electronic device (tablets, phones, etc.) as everyone will have Wi-Fi access so they can work on their own FAASafety.gov accounts.

Directions: Proceed to Fernando Luis Ribas Dominicci Airport at Isla Gande, PR. Take the main road toward the PR Ports Authority passenger terminal. Continue past the terminal and the ATC control tower to the Interamerican University Aeronautical Building.
