

## Meet Your Aviation Medical Examiner

While we have discussed how to keep flying without a medical certificate in past meetings, Dr. Craig Dunn, a senior medical examiner/AME will discuss how you can maintain your Medical Certificate even if it requires a "Special Issuance" Certificate. In the last year, the FAA has made it easier for your "local" medical examiner to issue such a certificate.
