## No Man's Land

It happens to every aviator at some point during a cross-country: you must fly a distance over hostile terrain or open water. There is no good place to land in an emergency. What's your plan to ensure that you spend the minimum amount of time in "No man's land" ? How do you minimize the risk of a ditching or swamp / forest landing for you and your passengers? In this seminar we'll talk about flight planning and inflight strategies that work.

**Directions:** Take Treeline Ave. to RSW airport entrance road. Turn into airport. Turn left at light for Perimeter Road (follow signs for FBO and Cargo). Head north around the west end of the runway. Once you turn east, look on your left for the sign for the Training Center.
