

A Practical Guide To Airspace

This seminar reviews basic airspace characteristic, while placing emphasis on practical aspects. Topics of discussion include: Florida airspace, VFR operations in class B airspace, class D airports with TRSA, differentiating class E and G airspace and ATC handoff procedures. The information provides an excellent review for both VFR and IFR pilots, as well as student pilots. In addition, the local FAA Safety Program Manager will present statistical data on pilot deviation that occurred within the Tampa FSDO geographical boundaries.
