Managing Unexpected Events and Pilots and Medications

In this event we'll talk about:

Accidents caused by mis-managing an unexpected event: the cabin door opening shortly after takeoff. Then we'll look at examples of things that happen in flight, unexpectedly, that can result in emergencies and, if not managed correctly, accidents. We'll take a quick look at the Five Stages of Grief, AKA the Kubler-Ross Model, and how each stage affects your decision making and management of emergencies.

Finally, we'll suggest some strategies for what to and what to practice to be ready when the unexpected occurs.

Recent studies that features some interesting findings with respect to pilots and medications, flying while medicating and the problems associated with taking multiple drugs. Finally we'll offer some tips for safe flying while on medications and we'll discuss a case study.
