

## Know Your Limits in Windy Conditions

Every Spring the wind gets to blowing, here, and just about everywhere in the U.S. and Canada. Often it doesn't blow right down the runway, either. It is time to remember our high wind and crosswind flying techniques, to prevent losing control of the airplane close to the ground. This presentation should refresh your memory on classic crosswind and high-wind takeoff and landing techniques in different airplanes. It will also emphasize establishing personal wind limits for flying that make sense, based on pilot proficiency and pilot skills.

**Directions:** Access the training center via either Daniels Parkway to the Cargo Road entrance, turning right just before Private Sky Aviation. Follow the road around to the right and watch signage for the building. From the south enter the RSW Airport and follow signs for Cargo and FBO around to the north side of the runway. The building will be on your left before the left turn to go to the Cargo and FBO areas.
