Join us in a journey into obtaining your Remote Pilot Certificate issued under Part 107 for Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

The new federal regulation, 14 CFR Part 107 was created to integrate Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS) into the National Airspace System. Part 107 allows sUAS operations for commercial purposes. The seminar will address how to become certified as a Remote Pilot, overview the new operational limitations, and address special operations and waivers. Rules for hobby and recreational use of sUAS platforms will also be discussed
