How do we access the current and forecast weather information for our departure and destination airports? What about along our route? How has the availability and access to weather information changed?

Aviation Weather Services have changed dramatically over the years. Not too long ago we had to go into a Flight Service Station and weed through printed charts and reports as well as talking with an agent, then during flight we had to contact FSS or Flight Watch and ask for the current weather both enroute and at our destination. Now, we have almost instantaneous graphical information inflight on our panel avionics and/or on an iPad. How do we handle these changes to ensure we get a good proper Weather Briefing?

Pilots of all experience levels are welcome including Student pilots, Newly Rated pilots, Experienced pilots, Rusty pilots, and CFI's. Non-pilots that are interested in aviation and aviation safety are also welcomed to attend. The FAASeminar Team Seminars at KPCM are held as organized "Hangar Flying with the focus on building a safety consciousness among pilots.
