Each year there is a disproportionate number of fatal aviation accidents involving Light Sport, Experimental and Amateur Home Built aircraft. Owner/Operator Maintenance is sometimes indicated as causal factors along with incomplete knowledge about specific aerodynamic characteristics of these aircraft that are not type certificated.
