NMPA Mountain Flying Familiarization Clinic

Flying the Rocky Mountains with its dozens of high altitude public and private airports can be an exhilarating experience for any pilot and can provide easy access to many areas with incredible historical, cultural, and recreational opportunities. But it can also be a hazardous experience for those unaware of the unique variables encountered in mountain flight and the effects on aircraft and pilot performance. In New Mexico, accident statistics show that pilots without the skills needed for safe flight over mountainous terrain often get themselves into situations which are beyond their capability to safely handle. The mountain flying familiarization clinic is a program developed by the New Mexico Pilots Association to improve that capability.

Directions: Go west on Airport Road, past highway 599 and Aviation Drive (entrance to KSAF). Airport Road changes names at this point to Paseo Real. Continue west a little over ½ mile and take the first left turn onto Huey Road. The clinic will be in the classroom building to your right as you enter the ANG complex.
