

Mountain Flying Clinic-Optional Flight

Optional flight portion of NMPA annual Mountain Flying Clinic; approx. 4 hour flight into the Rocky Mountains to apply and practice skills learned in the ground school; successful completion of the ground school is required. Flight involves six mountain passes, 5 mountain airports, and flight over mountainous terrain ranging up to 13,000msl. Successful completion of ground school and this flight option meets the requirements for a flight review. Flight requirements, registration procedures, and costs can be found at www.nmpilots.org.
