Albuquerque Balloon Fiesta Mini Seminar - NTSB Investigating and Reporting

This presentation will discuss the flight scenarios that lead to fatal ballooning accidents and the links in the chains of events that lead to them. The NTSB's investigations identified points at which different decisions could have broken links in the accident chain which may have allowed the accidents to be avoided. Using the 16 fatality accident that occurred near Lockhart, Texas, the presentation will discuss the investigating procedures that the NTSB begins with notification that an accident occurred and ends with at least a finding of a probable cause. Sometimes the NTSB will issue safety recommendations beyond the finding of probable cause.
