From Exit 276 off I-25 south of Santa Fe, drive east on NM599 to its intersection with NM14. Turn south on NM14 and follow it approximately 38 miles. Turn west onto La Madera Road. The entrance to the Vista Grande Community Center is the first driveway on your right. If you reach the junction of NM14 with Sandia Crest Road (NM536/NM306), you have gone to far. Reverse course and look for La Madera Road to the west.

East of Albuquerque, take Exit 175, the NM 14, Cedar Crest exit, off I-40. Stay in the left lane and follow NM14 for approximately one mile where it will cross under I-40 and go north. Drive approximately 8 miles until you pass through the village of San Antonito and pass through the junction with Cedar Crest Road (NM536/NM306). Turn west onto La Madera Road. The entrance to the Vista Grande Community Center is the first driveway on your right.
