Directions: From I-25, take Veterans Memorial Highway NM 599 exit #276. Go 3.5 mi. north to Paseo Real/Airport Road. Next left is Aviation Dr. Sierra Aviation is .7 mi. up Aviation Drive on the right. Pilots arriving by air should ask for parking on the North Ramp, located north of the tower and the Jet Center at Santa Fe. Sierra is in the former Millionaire building. Ramp access is restricted by TSA; transient pilots must be escorted by a pilot or worker displaying an SAF badge.
