**Directions:** Driving from Houston: Follow Interstate 290 until passing to the north of Waller. Turn right (north) onto 362 for 5.5 miles until the 1488 intersection. Turn left on 1488 and immediately turn right onto 1736. Continue north on 1736 for 2.6 miles until it turns left, but continue straight (north) on Waller Gladish Rd when 1736 goes left (west). Turn right (east) on Howell Rd which is 1.2 miles after the Waller Gladish junction with 1736. The SCOH entrance is about 300 yds on the left (north side) of Howell road.
