Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) and knowing how to avoid them are an important part of aviation, especially in a large metropolitan area. TFRs specific to Houston will be discussed (stadiums), as well as regulations regarding the different types of TFRs that pilots can be expected to see around the country. Intercept procedures as a result of a TFR violation will also be discussed.
