

# Flying in/out of Class B airports-tips and tricks for the general aviation pilot

Subjects covered: Communications, wake turbulence and jet blast avoidance, "hot" approaches, airport signage, advantages of flying in IFR vs. VFR, avoiding departure/arrival pushes, situational awareness for landing on the correct pavement, hot spots, EDCTs and call for release, fees

**Directions:** FLYING IN: Park your airplane on the Gill Aviation Ramp, and the American Flyers office is right next to Gill Aviation. DRIVING: From I-45: Exit FM2920 west until you get to Stuebner-Airline Rd. Take a left on Stuebner-Airline rd and the main terminal is the first right after the gas station. Park in the parking lot in front of Gill Aviation. The American Flyers office is right next to Gill on the left hand side from the parking lot.
