

Getting a Little Too Hot & Heavy... Density Altitude and Weight vs. Performance

It's getting to be hotter and hotter as summer approaches. This calls for more careful consideration of airplane performance. Don't be a test pilot by exceeding limitations! This interactive discussion focuses on density altitude, weight, and how all of it effects airplane performance.

Directions: Directions to Venue: From Pearland Regional Airport (LVJ):After exiting from the FBO and airport on Airfield Ln, turn left and drive for about .5 miles. Make a right onto CR127 (first right) and the restaurant is about 200ft on your left hand side. It is almost within walking distance from the airport.From Downtown Houston:Take I-45 south and exit Hasting-Friendswood Rd (FM 2351). Make a right on FM2351 and follow it for about 5 miles until you come to CR 127. Take a right on CR127 and the restaurant is on the right hand side about 500ft down the road.
