As winter approaches, it's time to prepare for safe winter flying. Learn about the elements that make winter flying uniquely different. Does my aircraft need any special attention to prepare for winter operations? How is winter weather different and what unique risks does it present? How do I mitigate or avoid those risks? How do I get a good weather briefing and what special things should I look for? How can I become better at understanding forecasting winter weather and choosing the safest routes? What factors can lead to loss of control in-flight in winter flying conditions, and how do I avoid them?
