FLYING IN:

Pilots flying in will be required to read the applicable NOTAM for the event. This is a fly-in event similar to Oshkosh and Sun N Fun that has specific procedures. Aircraft - tent camping is by reservation only.

Pilots flying in will be directed to parking by ATC Ground on 120.45, and other ground personnel. Tie-downs for your aircraft are required if not on a ramp. Aircraft parked on the ramp are required to bring their own wheel chocks.

Shuttle service will be provided from the aircraft parking areas to the main event at the Fairgrounds across the street, but is within easy walking distance as well.

DRIVING IN:

Ground guides will be directing traffic and will be handling the parking of vehicles.
