In 2018, up to 8/1/18, the FAA had over 130 presidential TFR Pilot Deviations into the Bedminster TFR. Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) and knowing how to avoid them are an important part of aviation, especially in a large metropolitan area that often experiences presidential TFRs. TFRs specific to New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and New York will be discussed, as well as the regulations regarding the different types of TFRs that pilots can be expected to see around the country. Intercept procedures will also be discussed in the event that a TFR violation leads to an airborne intercept.
