Directions: The Sebastian County Emergency Management headquarters is located on the south east corner of Zero and Massard Street. It is the former National Guard Armory. If arriving via interstate 540 ,take exit # 11 off of 540. Turn east on Zero street. The Second traffic light, about 3 miles, east is located at Massard Rd. and Zero St.. The building location is on the right located on the southeast corner of that intersection. If arriving via Rogers Avenue turn south on Massard Rd and travel 1.8 miles south to the Traffic light at Massard and Zero street. The building is located on the south east corner of that intersection.
