

Safety Seminar - Review of Accidents in Arkansas, and Medical Certification Process

Review of accidents experienced in Arkansas followed by discussion on potential preventive actions. Discussion led by Inspector Nick Cusimano, LIT FSDO, focusing on Loss of Control, and preventive actions to avoid loss of control of your aircraft. Second hour will be a discussion on FAA Medical Certification Process. Discussion led by AME, Dr. Michael Stroud from Stroud Aviation. Dr Stroud will review conditions which the FAA classifies as disqualifying and will review prescription and non-prescription medications to include a review of the Special Issuance Process. Time permitting, Dr Stroud will lead an open discussion on potential changes to the Medical Certification Process.
