

## Sparrow Ground Training

This will be 2 one-hour modules of the above mentioned subjects with a 10 minute break between sessions. Starts at 0900 sharp and out by 1130. Several videos by the AOPA Air Safety Institute followed by class discussion and debrief. If time allows, first hand stories of similar experiences encouraged. The subject matter will be referenced from the FAR/AIM, Pilots Handbook of Aeronautical Knowledge and Gleim Sport Pilot and Private Pilot Course textbooks. Seating is limited, so ON-LINE registration strongly suggested. Coffee/Orange Juice and bagels provided by Sparrow Flying Club.

**Directions:** From Conway area, head west on Dave Ward drive until Lollie Rd. Left of Lollie for 4 1/2 miles. If arriving via I-40 from LIT area, take exit 135 (Mayflower), cross back over interstate and look for Hwy 89N. Takes about 15 min drive to airport from Mayflower.
