This is a back-to-basics event focusing on the fundamentals of navigation in a fun and hands-on way.

The seminar presentation will cover situational awareness, planning for and identifying ground features, and basic navigation techniques. The flying portion will put to test the lessons from the Seminar. The objective (in addition to having fun) is to enhance navigational/positional awareness skills and avoid the automation pitfalls of Technologically Advanced Aircraft (TAA) -- landing at the wrong airport or being caught by surprise when the glass or GPS malfunctions.
