Kickapoo Scavenger Hunt

This Safety Seminar / Fly-In will focus on one of navigation's basic principles – pilotage (navigation by visual reference to landmarks) with emphasis on one of the leading accident causes; loss of control (LOC). We will review the critical areas for LOC and also review the practical test standards for performance, take offs, and landings. You will be provided an envelope containing clues about the turn points of your route before take-off. At each turn point, you will be asked to complete a specific task. Emphasis will be on situational awareness and minimization of hazardous distractions during critical phases of flight.

In the interest of safety, you are encouraged to share this experience with another pilot or your favorite Navigator/Safety Observer.
