The first part entitled "SRM - Risk Mitigation During Planning and Execution" will look at each risk factor during the planning and execution phases of a flight then look at how to reflect on a mission in comparison to the plan. The second part entitled "Sliding to the Landing...Playgrounds and Runways" is a Designated Pilot Examiner's analogy of a playground slide giving a nice, smooth approach and transition for another turn on the slide.
