General Engle commanded the second orbital test flight of the Space Shuttle "Columbia", launched from Kennedy Space Center, FL. On this flight he became the first and only pilot to manually fly an aerospace vehicle from Mach 25 to landing.



General Engle was Commander of Space Shuttle "Discovery" on flight 51-I which launched from Kennedy Space Center on 27 Aug 1985. The crew deployed three communications satellites, and

performed a successful on-orbit rendezvous and manual repair of the disabled SYCOM communications satellite.


General Engle has flown over 185 different types of aircraft including 38 different fighter and attack aircraft. He has logged more than 14,700 flight hours; 9,900 in jets and over 224 hours in space.
