General Engle will speak about his career from the University of Kansas ROTC program, to flying Tactical Fighters, then USAF Test Pilot, USAF Aerospace Research Pilot, X-15 pilot (16 flights), Astronaut (flight above a 50 mile altitude (264,000 feet). General Engle is the youngest pilot to qualify as an astronaut. General Engle is the only pilot to hand fly an aerospace vehicle from Mach 25 to landing.
