# WINGS Common Flight Activities and How to Get WINGS Credit

Below you will find easy instructions and a short list of common WINGS Flight Activities. This will help you find and request WINGS Credit from your local CFI's or your local FAA Safety Representative. Your Goal is to earn a WINGS Phase. As a result, you will have earned a FAA Flight Review!

As a WINGS pilot you will:

- Maintain currency and proficiency,
- Improve your knowledge and skills, and
- Join a group of pilots with an UNPRECEDENTED SAFETY RECORD!

The WINGS program awards eligible pilots with a Basic, Advanced, or Master Phase of WINGS based on completion of a specific set of <u>Knowledge</u> (courses or seminars) and <u>Flight</u> Activities. As an <u>added bonus</u>, you can satisfy the requirement for a <u>Flight Review</u> by simply completing any <u>Phase</u> of WINGS.

Note:

- Basic WINGS is equivalent to private piloting skills
- Advanced WINGS is equivalent to commercial piloting skills
- Master WINGS is equivalent to ATP piloting skills

#### Step 1:

During your Flight Planning, discuss your proposed Flight Activities with your CFI. Then, log into your faasafety.gov then navigate to the "Pilots" tab then select "My WINGS". Here you will be able to view your current WINGS - Phase progress and select your next Flight activities and Knowledge courses.

#### Step 2:

Que up your planned Flight Activities: While viewing your WINGS Phase, in the Flight Activities section, press the "Find Alternate Activities" link to browse for a flight activities. If you don't see what you want go straight to Step 5 for the streamlined process.

#### Step 4:

When done queuing up your flights, return back to your My WINGS page and select "Print Your Checklist" aka your CFI log page endorsement. Share with your CFI and discuss your WINGS Checklist.

#### Step 5:

For the streamline process: Navigate to the "Activities, Courses, Seminar & Webinars" tab and select "Activities" enter in a below Accredited Activity Number or search in the search field. Click on the "Activity Name" Then select "Request Credit", here you can search for your CFI, FAAST Rep or FPM.

Remember, Completion of a Flight Activity is based on the satisfactory completion of the Flight Activity to the Proficiency Level reflected by the Pilot Certificate that the Pilot holds (Sport, Recreational, Private, Commercial, ATP). However, a Commercial Certified Pilot can complete both Basic and Advanced Phases and an ATP Certified Pilot can earn Basic, Advanced and Master Phases. The Pilot must earn the phases in order; Basic, then Advanced, then Master. The Activity must be accomplished in the presence of a CFI.

A Logbook entry MUST be made by the CFI in the Pilot's logbook indicating completion of the Flight Activity by Activity Number with the CFI signature, certificate number and expiration date.
