Meteorological Assessments for Cloud Seeding Operations

The South Texas Weather Modification Association was been in conducting cloud seeding operations in South Texas since 1997. The attached map shows the areas in their "Target" area. This is based on the Counties that contribute to the cost of seeding operations. Their primary operating location is the Pleasanton airport with occational flights out of Stinson Fld and Beeville. They have their own radar at Pleasanton but now primarily use feeds from NOAA Doppler radar. The presentaion will be made by Todd Flannagan who has been their meteorologist since the beginning of operations. He will also have one of the pilots available to address the operation from the cockpit. Both will be available to answer questions. They will have slides of past seeding operations. Todd provides direction to the most likely clouds and the pilot has had training to recognize cloud and wind patterns to place the seeding material in the optimum positions. Todd can track the aircraft position on his radar via a data link from the aircraft. I think you will find this an interesting presentation.
