This is also an opportunity to learn from the airport Air Traffic Control Team, Airport Management, operators on the field, and from your fellow pilots.

Please take the time to participate as an active part in your Aviation Community, and to add your weight to move the risk-pendulum toward SAFETY.

There is no pre-planned ground transportation from the General Aviation Ramp to the Airport Management Office. Pilots who elect to fly-in must make their own arrangements for ground transportation.

DRIVING IN - From Interstate Highway IH-35 - Exit onto Texas Hwy 80 to the east; Exit onto Texas Hwy 21 to the Northeast; After passing the entrance to the San Marcos Airport, the Airport Management Office will be on your Right.
