Then we bring a Cessna 172S into our Virtual Shop and perform Airworthiness Directives (AD) research. The FAA DRS Website is used to identify Applicable ADs.

We will search for Aircraft, Engine, Propeller, and Appliance ADs. Emergency ADs and Bi-Weekly Listings are also reviewed. Techniques, Tips, and Limitations are discussed. This Presentation also demonstrates how to generate AD lists from DRS.
