

POSTPONED - Randolph Air Force Base - Civil Fly-In

POSTPONEMENT ANNOUNCEMENT -

The Randolph AFB Civil Fly-In event scheduled for this Saturday, 17 June 2023 has been **postponed to *next* Saturday, 24 June 2023**. Aside from this change in date, all prior registrations, PPRs issued, and the schedule of events remains unchanged.

Smoke from controlled agricultural burns in Mexico are impacting ceiling and visibility across south Texas. Our weather team assesses that conditions will continue to worsen through Saturday, pushing ceiling and visibility below VFR minimums during our planned arrival window.

As eager as we all are here at Randolph to have the pleasure of your attendance, we make this determination with the safety of our guests in mind. We apologize for any inconvenience or conflicts that this decision to postpone will cause any of you.
