FLYING IN - Set your GPS to KHYI, Direct, Enter - From the North talk to Austin Approach; From the South talk to San Antonio Approach; After landing, tell Ground Control you want to park at Berry Aviation. If you plan on this method, call ahead, you will need to use the courtesy vehicle to get to the meeting, which is on Highway 21. Event organizers are not providing transportation from the airfield to the event.

DRIVING IN - From Interstate Highway IH-35 – Exit 205 and go East on SR-80; After crossing the Blanco River, exit Right and turn Left (NorthEast) on SR-21; Drive past the airport entrance, ATC building is on the right.
