Flying-In - Set your GPS to 8T8 and select "Direct-To, Enter, Enter"; Communicate with San Antonio Approach and avoid the TFRs;and look at the Sectional, there's is an 1,128 foot tower (AGL) a few miles ENE. Bring your own tie-downs. Once you are on the ground, Park at the North end in the grass as shown in this [picture](#).

Driving-In - From Hwy 1604, turn Northwest on Culebra (FM 471) and drive for seven (7) miles; Turn Left into San Geronimo Air Park. EAA Chapter 35 Club House is the first building on the left. Gated entrance on west side of Culebra Rd. If gate is closed call (210) 386-5009.

Walking-In - Yeah; Like a pilot is going to walk that far! Probably NOT! You may want to try a Taxi or Ride-Share.

VMC Club ends at 11 am. Regular monthly gathering starts at 11:30 with a donation lunch.
